



Non-violent Crisis Intervention (CPI Training)

Teachers and DIS support staff working with students in ED programs. All other SDC/RSP staff are welcome to attend.

1. Learn to respond effectively to the warning signs that someone may be losing control.
2. Learn how to avoid & take control of an out of control situation.
3. Learn how to deal with stress, anxiety and emotions when confronted with challenging situations.

Training will provide ED staff with support to avoid and take control of a challenging situation, while continuing to promote care, welfare, safety and security. Initial certification requires a 2-day attendance followed by an annual 3-4 hour re-certification class.
