Verification for Teachers in Special Settings (VPSS) Training 2009/2010

All Alternative Education and Special Education Teachers must become highly qualified in all subject matter areas they teach. The Verification Process for Teachers In Special Settings (VPSS) classes are one option teachers may select to become highly qualified in the four core academic subject areas. Teachers completing the 72 hours (VPSS Levels I & II) will be considered highly qualified in that subject area. Some teachers may have the academic units to be excused from Level I and only need to attend Level II. Classes in Math, English and Science are being offered this fall and spring at SCOE.
