
#### Advocacy and Leadership

### **10 State of California Priorities**

Priority 1: Basic Services and Conditions at schools Text books availability, adequate facilities, and correctly assigned teachers

Priority 2: Implementation of State Academic Standards Annually report on progress in implementing the standards for all content areas

Priority 3: Parent Engagement Annually report progress toward: (1) seeking input from parents/guardians in decision making; and (2) promoting parental participation in programs

Priority 4: Student Achievement Academic Performance (Grades 3-8 and Grade 11), English Learner Progress

**Priority 5: Student Engagement** Graduation Rate, Chronic Absenteeism

**Priority 6: School Climate** Suspension Rate, Administer a Local Climate Survey every other year

Priority 7: Access to a Broad Course of Study Annually report progress on the extent students have access to, and are enrolled in, a broad course of study.

Priority 8: Outcomes in a Broad Course of Study College/Career

Priority 9: (COEs Only) Coordination of Services for Expelled Students Annual measure of progress in coordinating instruction for expelled students

Priority 10: (COEs Only) Coordination of Services for Foster Youth Annual measure of progress in coordinating instruction for foster youth
