Do you have a student who needs immediate crisis support for a mental health concern?

Contact the School Mental Health Crisis Response!

What happens when you call:

- A SCOE Crisis Specialist will complete a brief crisis intake with you on the phone
- SCOE will respond in-person to your school site within 30 minutes
- A Crisis Risk Assessment will be completed with the student
- Based on the assessment determination:
- SCOE will assist in stabilizing the student and connecting them to immediate resources, and/or
- SCOE will initiate a 5150 and call for medical transport

Additional Information:

- Services provided during school hours, 8:00am-4:30pm
- No insurance requirements
- SCOE responds in partnership with law enforcement when there is an overt safety risk
