VII. HEARING CLOSES – CLOSED SESSION DELIBERATIONS BEGIN

Pursuant to Board Policy 9000.21(II)(C), Education Code §§49073 et seq., 20 U.S.C. §1232g, and 34 C.F.R. Part 99 (FERPA), the Board may adjourn to closed session to deliberate the appeal.

VIII. RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION

The Board will report on action taken in closed session (if applicable). The Board may (1) grant the appeal, (2) deny the appeal, or (3) remand the matter back to the district that initially denied the attendance request.
